O₃4ME Exceptional and Creative Teaching in Mathematics recognizes an exceptional and creative mathematics educator who demonstrates excellence in mathematics education and contributes to the overall development of students in the Ottawa Zone (Elementary or Secondary).

Award Nomination Process

1. Complete the Nominee and Nominator information section below. The nominator may include a 1-page letter of recommendation. Nominee does not necessarily have to be an OAME member - nominator does.
2. Provide up to three letters of support, of no more than two pages each. These supporting documents may be gathered from a variety of sources to reveal a full picture of the nominee. The support documents will provide precise information about the nominee’s contributions as they relate primarily to this award. All documentation supporting a nomination should align to the OAME and O₃4ME’s Vision for mathematics teaching and learning. Support may come from current OAME members, a supervisor or administrator, colleagues, or other appropriate sources.
3. Include the nominee’s Curriculum Vitae/resume of up to five pages.

The nominations will be assessed according to the criteria outlined below:
